INFORMATION REGARDING INTERMENTS AT ROSS BAY CEMETERY

The following is provided to give information to families regarding interments at historical Ross Bay Cemetery. Guidelines are in place to ensure that the process is conducted with dignity and respect while provincial regulations, municipal bylaws and policies are adhered to. Additional information is available in the Ross Bay Cemetery bylaws and in the Cremation, Interment and Funeral Services Act.

The City of Victoria allows full interments as well as interments of cremated remains at Ross Bay Cemetery. Application for an interment is made (with a minimum of 48 hours notice) to the Parks Permit Clerk via a funeral service provider or directly by the family. The following paperwork is required:

- Proof of ownership or documentation sufficient to prove right to use the plot
- A copy of the Cremation Certificate or Certificate of Death.
- Order for Interment
- An information sheet for statistical records
- Applicable interment fees. There is an additional charge for Saturday burials or services extending past 4:00pm on weekdays.

Once the above paperwork is received and payment is made a burial permit will be produced and a time for interment may be arranged.
