VICTORIA, BC — The Victoria Fire Department reminds residents to change smoke detector batteries this weekend during the switch from Daylight Savings Time.

Consider it one more clock that needs to be changed. The most important one.

Residents should test smoke alarms once a month, replace any smoke alarm that is more than 10 years old, and change smoke alarm batteries routinely in the spring and fall when clocks are changed.
