



View Street Parkade to Close for Month of January

VICTORIA, BC — Concrete repairs are all that is left to complete at View Street Parkade. To accommodate the work, the parkade will close for the month of January, reopening on February 1, 2009. This will be the only full closure for the parkade, however, alternating floor closures will occur up until May.

Over the past year, the City of Victoria has been making significant improvements to its five parkades to provide a safe and inviting downtown parking experience. Improvements to date include a new painting scheme and new international-standardized directional signage. Safety upgrades include reducing hidden corners and the installation of large windowed doors in stairwells.

View Street Parkade monthly parkers have been contacted by mail and will be able to park at the Broughton and Johnson Street Parkades from January to April 2009 at a reduced rate.
