A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend the Parks Regulation Bylaw to prohibit the use of Pioneer Square at night.

Under its statutory powers, including sections 8(3)(a) and (b), (7), and (8), and 62 of the *Community Charter*, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

- 1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "PARKS REGULATION BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 11)".
- 2 Bylaw No. 91-19, the Parks Regulation Bylaw, is amended in section 25(1) by adding the following paragraph:

"(c) Pioneer Square is the park and cemetery that is

- (i) bounded on 3 sides by Rockland Avenue, Quadra Street, and Meares Street, and
- (ii) legally described as all that parcel of land situate at the southeast corner of Quadra and Mears Streets, in the City of Victoria, marked Cemetery on the Official Plan of the City of Victoria, more particularly described as that parcel of land in Victoria City bounded on the north by Mears Street, on the east by Lot 2005, Victoria City, Plan 35C, on the south by Rockland Avenue and on the west by Quadra."

- 3 Section 25(2) is amended by adding the following paragraph:

"(c) Pioneer Square."

READ A FIRST TIME the **2nd** day of **December,** 2004.

READ A SECOND TIME the **2nd** day of **December,** 2004.

READ A THIRD TIME the **2nd** day of **December,** 2004.
