

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend the Property Maintenance Bylaw as a result of the change in the City's governance structure.

Under its statutory powers, including sections 8(3)(h) 16, 17, 64, 258 and 260 to 263 of the *Community Charter*, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

- 1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "PROPERTY MAINTENANCE BYLAW AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO.1)".
- 2 The Property Maintenance Bylaw is amended in section 2 by adding the following definition immediately before the definition of "graffiti":

"Committee" means the standing committee of Council known as the Planning and Land Use Standing Committee.'
- 3 The Property Maintenance Bylaw is further amended:
 - (a) in sections 8(2), 8(3) and 8(4) by deleting the words "Private Property Maintenance Committee" wherever they appear and substituting the word "Committee"; and
 - (b) in section 8(2) by striking out the words "established under the Property Maintenance Hearing Delegation Bylaw".
