

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

to amend the Sign Bylaw to create the Dockside Sign Zone and its regulations.

Under its statutory powers, including sections 579 and 967 of the Municipal Act and section 12 of the Victoria City Act, 1922, the Municipal Council of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "SIGN BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 3)."
2. Bylaw No. 92-30, the Sign Bylaw, is amended in section 3 by adding the following words after Part 10:

"Part 11 Dockside Sign Zone."
3. The Sign Bylaw is further amended in section 5.1 by adding the following paragraph:

"(e) the Dockside Sign Zone."
4. The Sign Bylaw is further amended by adding the following Part after Part 10:

"PART 11

DOCKSIDE SIGN ZONE

14.1 Permitted Signs

The signs permitted in the Dockside Sign Zone are a

- (a) fascia sign;
- (b) projecting sign; and
- (c) suspended sign.

14.2 Regulations

Unless otherwise stated, the sign allowance permitted in the Dockside Sign Zone is a 1 to 1 ratio requirement.

14.3 Material and Illumination

- (1) Sign panels with backlighting are prohibited in the Dockside Sign Zone.
- (2) Signs in the Dockside Sign Zone must be made of
 - (a) enamelled metal, painted metal or painted wood; and
 - (b) metal or wooden letters."

5. The Sign Bylaw is further amended by repealing Schedule A and substituting the Schedule A attached to this Bylaw.
