A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend the Animal Control Bylaw to give police officers the same power as the poundkeeper and licence inspector to demand specified information from a person having custody of a dog.

Under its statutory powers, including section 703 of the *Local Government Act*, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

- 1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 6)".
- 2 Bylaw No. 92-189, the Animal Control Bylaw, is amended in section 33 by striking out "poundkeeper or Licence Inspector" and substituting "poundkeeper, Licence Inspector, or municipal police constable".
