

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend the Animal Control Bylaw to extend the deadline by which a surcharge is payable for overdue renewal of a dog tag.

Under its statutory powers, including section 8(3)(k) of the *Community Charter*, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

- 1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 8)".
- 2 Bylaw No. 92-189, the Animal Control Bylaw, is amended in section 27 by adding the following subsection:

“(5) In the year 2004 only, the amount of \$10.00 referred to in subsection (2) takes effect after April 30, instead of after March 1st.”
