A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend the Animal Control Bylaw to increase the licence fee for dogs.

Under its statutory powers, including section 8(3)(k) of the *Community Charter*, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

- 1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO.9)".
- 2 Bylaw No. 92-189, the Animal Bylaw, is amended
 - (a) in section 25(1)(a) by striking out "\$15.00" and substituting "\$25.00", and
 - (b) in section 25(1)(b) by striking out "\$25.00" and substituting "\$35.00".

READ A SECOND TIME the **27th** day of **January,** 2005.

READ A THIRD TIME the **27th** day of **January,** 2005.
