A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

to permit dogs to run at large south of Dallas Road in the area specifically identified in the Bylaw.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 1)."
  
2. Bylaw No. 92-189, the Animal Control Bylaw, is amended by repealing section 9 and substituting the following:
  - "9. (1) Unless the dog is firmly held on a leash not exceeding 2.4 m in length or a retractable lead of not more than 8 m in length, fully extended, and held by a person competent to restrain the dog, no person shall at any time cause or allow a dog owned by that person to be in any street, lane or other public place or in any public park.
  
  - (2) The provisions of subsection (1) do not apply in that portion of Beacon Hill Park lying south of Dallas Road nor in the area lying south of Dallas Road near the foot of Moss Street, commonly known as Clover Point, so long as the dog is accompanied by and under the effective control of a competent person.
