

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

to amend the Building Bylaw to set a reasonable time in which a building permit is to be picked up.

Under its statutory powers, including Sections 19 and 933(1)(b) of the Municipal Act, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "BUILDING BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 3)."
2. Bylaw No. 93-111, the Building Bylaw, is amended in section 4.3 by adding the following paragraph:  

"(3) An application for a building permit may be deemed to be withdrawn if the building permit for which the application has been made has not been issued within 6 months of the date of notification to the applicant that the building permit is ready to be issued."
