A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

to amend the Animal Control Bylaw to lower minimum fines and voluntary penalties as a consequence of the establishment of a set fine approved by the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court for the purposes of the Municipal Information Ticketing System under section 934.1 of the Municipal Act.

Under its statutory powers, including section 294 of the Municipal Act, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 4)."
2. Bylaw No. 92-189, the Animal Control Bylaw, is amended by repealing section 40(3) and substituting the following subsection:

"(3) The minimum penalty for a contravention of section 34(2) and (3) that is not a contravention described in subsection (2) is

- (a) for the first contravention, a fine of \$200.00,
- (b) for the second contravention, a fine of \$300.00,
- (c) for a third or subsequent contravention, a fine of \$500.00,"
