A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

to amend the Building Bylaw to allow the Building Inspector to refuse to issue a permit if the property to which the permit would apply has been found to be in contravention of a Bylaw of the City.

Under its statutory powers, including section 734 of the Municipal Act, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts the following provisions:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "BUILDING BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 5)."
2. Bylaw No. 93-111, the Building Bylaw, is amended in section 4.9 by striking out "or" at the end of paragraph (b), by adding "or" at the end of paragraph (c), and by adding the following paragraph:

"(d) the property for which the permit is applied for has been found to be in contravention of a Bylaw of the City."
