



Greater Victoria Public Library Board Terms of Reference

Greater Victoria Public Library Board (GVPLB) was formed by the municipalities of Victoria, Oak Bay, Saanich, and Esquimalt to provide for the joint management, maintenance, improvement, operation, and control of the central Library and branches, as well as the establishment of branches in member municipalities. Details of this volunteer position are:

1. The GVPL Board is composed of 21 members with five appointees from the City of Victoria.
2. Victoria City Council appoints one elected official and four residents of the City of Victoria.
3. Citizen members must have resided in the City for at least six months preceding the appointment. Citizen members serve two-year terms to a maximum of four consecutive terms (or eight years).

Victoria Airport Authority Mandate

The Victoria Airport Authority Board is the governing body of the community-operated Victoria International Airport. Its role is to manage, operate and develop the airport for which it is responsible in a safe, secure, efficient, cost effective and financially viable manner with reasonable airport user charges and equitable access to all air carriers; to undertake and promote the development of the airport lands for which it is responsible for uses compatible with air transportation activities; and to expand transportation facilities and generate economic activity in ways that are compatible with air transportation activities.
