



Have Your Say: Cecelia Ravine Park

VICTORIA, BC — The City of Victoria is looking for feedback on the draft concept plan for improvements to Cecelia Ravine Park.

In 2016, the City of Victoria purchased 0.5 acres of land to expand this park in the Burnside Gorge neighbourhood. Feedback from the community this summer helped inform the draft concept plan which includes a new, more accessible playground, pathway improvements, lighting, a picnic area and an improved fitness area.

Residents can share their feedback on the draft plan by attending the Open House or completing the online survey at victoria.ca/haveyoursay by October 29.

Date: Tuesday, October 24, 4 p.m. - 7 p.m.

Location: Burnside Gorge Community Centre, 471 Cecelia Road

Feedback from this round of engagement will be used to update the plan which will be taken to Council for approval. The park improvements are anticipated to begin in 2018.

About Cecelia Ravine Park:

Cecelia Ravine Park is the largest park in the Burnside Gorge Neighbourhood. It is one of the largest natural areas in the City of Victoria park system and features a creek, woodland areas, open meadows, and steep sided ravines.

The park currently includes a playground, bike skills park, basketball court, community garden, fitness equipment and numerous secondary trails and stairs. The Galloping Goose Regional Trail, operated by CRD Regional Parks, runs through this park.

This new park land can be accessed off of Cecelia Road and is located on the west side of the ravine. Engagement is currently underway.
