#### **Items Mayor will follow up on**

1. Introduce Kevin to Community Social Planning Council re: Community Investment Fund
2. Follow up with Planning Department to see what the hold up is from Speed and Frances getting back in front of Council
3. Follow up with BC Housing re: Gina's concern and situation
4. Follow up with BC Housing as to whether rent supplements can be used for secondary suites in homes or only for larger apartment buildings.
5. Follow up with planning department as to whether the new marina design can proceed with only the rip rap / wall improvements and not the hydro substation.
6. Follow up with Planning Department as to what authority the City has to exercise oversight of mechanical systems in strata buildings. Drop In participant said Richmond and Surrey have mechanical oversight bylaws.
7. Follow up with Engineering and Public Works Department with regard to Handicap Parking on 700 Block of Douglas Street as well as how many parking spots will be lost with BC Transit and Commercial Operator Bus Proposal.
8. Follow up with Engineering and Public Works Department about who what kinds of vehicles are eligible for a commercial loading and unloading permit.
