4. Does the Greater Victoria Harbour Authority need to do a Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Study for their rezoning application?
5. Send Victoria Adams the TDM study for Capital Park
6. Find out if Wilson's pays for the use of the sidewalks or just of the road space.
7. Ask if a port potty can be put in Reeson Park
8. Suggest to Randy Wright at Harbour Air that they create a display of the history of float planes
