2. Ask about crosswalk at Huron/Erie and Dallas Road, near new Fishermans Wharf Park

6. Look into removing section 49 (1) from Animal Control Bylaw (compelling argument from participant that this section no longer necessary because of introduction of dog licences)

7. Ask Citizen Engagement if we can have a place on the website that outlines all the work the City is doing to address Climate Change
