VICTORIA, BC —The Downtown Late Night Task Force is meeting with representatives from the transportation sector this afternoon, including BC Transit, the Taxi Driver's Association and private transportation companies.

Task force members Mayor Dean Fortin, Councillor Charlayne Thornton-Joe and Police Chief Jamie Graham meet with downtown stakeholders each Monday. The goal of the task force is to build a comprehensive strategy to ensure downtown remains vibrant, and balances the needs of local businesses, residents, visitors, and late night entertainment users.

Based on the information gathered, the task force will make recommendations to address late night downtown challenges to City Council in September.
