Today is the last in a series of individual meetings that saw task force members Mayor Dean Fortin, Councillor Charlayne Thornton-Joe and Police Chief Jamie Graham meeting with downtown stakeholders each Monday. The goal of the task force is to build a comprehensive strategy to ensure downtown remains vibrant, and balances the needs of local businesses, residents, visitors, and late night entertainment goers.
