



## Help Develop a Plan to Improve Traffic and Trails in Beacon Hill Park

VICTORIA, BC — Beacon Hill Park is an oasis of both natural and landscaped beauty, with unique recreation features that make it a destination for residents and visitors alike. Vehicle traffic within the park, however, is a safety concern due to speeding and the park's use as a short-cut by drivers. The City of Victoria is developing a plan that will guide traffic and trail improvements and increase public safety in the park.

The public and media are invited to attend an Open House this week to comment on interactive display boards and a computerized traffic simulation model, which will illustrate options for managing vehicle traffic and trail improvements in Beacon Hill Park.
