



Annual Water Main Flushing Begins Monday

VICTORIA, BC — Each year, Victoria's water mains are "flushed" to remove sediment and deliver high quality drinking water. Weather-permitting, the City of Victoria will begin water main flushing on Monday in Fairfield, Gonzales, Harris Green, James Bay, Rockland and downtown.

During this three month program, some water discolouration can be expected and short periods of low water pressure may be experienced. To prevent any staining from discoloured water, run tap water until clear.
