



City Welcomes New Solicitor Tom Zworski

VICTORIA, BC — Today is the first day on the job for the City of Victoria's new Solicitor, Tom Zworski.

"Municipal matters can often be complex and require a legal opinion," said Mayor Dean Fortin. "Having an in-house resource on a daily basis will make that expert advice more accessible to staff and Council."

A graduate of the University of Victoria, Zworski brings to his role more than 12 years of municipal experience as both a lawyer and a manager. He comes to Victoria from his position as a solicitor with the City of Vancouver, where he previously held the post of Manager of Information and Privacy. During his time in Vancouver he addressed the enforcement of bylaws, property tax appeals, and judicial reviews.

Under the general direction of City Manager, Gail Stephens, Tom Zworski will provide professional legal services to Council and staff. He will also be responsible for preparing contracts, leases and agreements authorized by Council, and review new provincial and federal legislation to ascertain their effects on the City. Zworski will also appear as City legal counsel in civil litigation cases.
