Over 500 elementary students from 10 different schools are expected to attend this year's Public Works Day with the theme *Above, Below, & All Around You*.

Engineering staff will be wearing T-shirts that feature the first place artwork. Designs were entered into a contest by students who attended last year's Public Works Day.

Students will tour interactive venues consisting of educational demonstrations and displays, as well as enjoy a barbecue lunch. Students will also be provided a ruler/calculator, an activity sheet and temporary tattoos of public works themes.
