VICTORIA, BC — Stage in the Park, commonly known as the Cameron Bandshell, comes alive each summer in Beacon Hill Park with a variety of free, outdoor musical performances. Join us for the popular *Concerts in the Park* series which kicks off with the *Dixieland Express* next Friday.

The series includes concerts for seniors on Fridays, jazz performances on Saturdays, and a broad range of music on Sundays and statutory holidays.

What: Sunday and Holiday Concerts in the Park
When: Sundays and Statutory Holidays from June 27 to September 19, 2010, from 1:30 to 3:20 p.m.
Where: Stage in the Park (Cameron Bandshell), Beacon Hill Park

Located off Arbutus and Bridge Ways in Beacon Hill Park, Cameron Bandshell is vibrant with activity from May to September each year. The stage hosts dance, theatre, band and choral performances, as well as a variety of community events. Bench seating and the surrounding grass areas are the perfect spot to relax and enjoy free performances.

The *Concerts in the Park* series is sponsored by the City of Victoria and the Music Performance Fund (MPF), as arranged through Local 247 of the American Federation of Musicians.

All *Concerts in the Park* are “rain or shine” (except for June 18) and are subject to change.
