



Johnson Street Bridge Survey Deadline Extended

VICTORIA, BC — An extensive effort is underway to make certain that every Victoria household has received a mail out package of information on the Johnson Street Bridge options. Packages include a detachable feedback form and postage paid envelope.

On August 12th, Victoria City Council will decide which bridge option to proceed with to address the 86 year old bridge.

With costs in mind, the City mailed out information packages through Canada Post by unaddressed mail. However some buildings, which have a no unsolicited mail policy, did not receive them. The City will make every effort to ensure that those residents also have access to the forms by direct mailing or hand delivering them.

The deadline for receiving the survey feedback forms has been extended to Tuesday, August 10, 2010.
