



Point Ellice Bridge to Close for Annual Maintenance

VICTORIA, BC — To accommodate annual maintenance, the Point Ellice Bridge will be closed on Wednesday, September 15, 2010 from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. Point Ellice Bridge, often referred to as the Bay Street Bridge, is located on Bay Street between Tyee Road and Pleasant Street.

City staff will be sealing cracks in the road surface of the bridge deck. The work is weather-dependent as the road surface must be dry. In the event of rain, the work will be rescheduled to another date.

Emergency services and BC Transit have been advised of the work and access across the bridge will be maintained for emergency vehicles, transit, cyclists and pedestrians in both directions. Signs will be posted and traffic control people will be on site to assist with traffic flow.

Motorists are encouraged to use other routes during this time.
