



Johnson Street Rail Bridge Walkway to Temporarily Close to Cyclists and Pedestrians

VICTORIA, BC — The Johnson Street Rail Bridge walkway will be closed to pedestrians and cyclists for repairs from Tuesday, September 21 to Wednesday, September 29, 2010, not including the weekend. To not interfere with peak travelling hours, the work will be carried out from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Repairs to the walkway's plywood and metal grating will improve public safety. The plywood has deteriorated and the metal grating is lifting in some areas.

Cyclists have the option of either cycling across the road bridge on the vehicle lanes or dismounting and walking across the bridge on the south sidewalk with pedestrians. Signs will be posted and traffic control people will be on site. Access to marine and rail traffic will be maintained.
