



Check Your Smoke Alarms While Changing Your Clocks

VICTORIA, BC — The Victoria Fire Department reminds residents to change household smoke alarm batteries this weekend during the switch from Daylight Saving Time. Clocks in North America “fall back” one hour at 2 a.m. on Sunday, November 7, 2010.

Consider your household smoke alarm to be the most important clock that needs to be changed.

Residents should test smoke alarms once a month, replace any smoke alarm that is more than 10 years old, and change smoke alarm batteries routinely in the spring and fall when clocks are changed.
