



Referendum and By-election Results To Be Made Available Saturday Evening

VICTORIA, BC — Results from the Johnson Street Bridge borrowing referendum, as well as the by-election for a Victoria Council seat, will be made available shortly after the polls close on Saturday, November 20.

The votes will be counted in the City Hall Council Chambers, using the AccuVote tabulation machines. Results should begin to come in by 8:05 p.m. shortly after the polls close. The advance polls will be counted first, followed by the general voting results.

Unofficial results should be available to the media by approximately 9:00 p.m. The results will be sent out via several means including media release, the Victoria Votes iPhone app, Facebook and Twitter. Mayor Dean Fortin will be available to comment on the final results at City Hall.
