



Unofficial JSB Referendum and By-Election Results

VICTORIA, BC — Unofficial results in the borrowing referendum and by-election have been tabulated, and the unofficial results of today's vote are now known.

In the Referendum asking voters to approve the borrowing bylaw to replace the Johnson Street Bridge, the referendum passed with 60.57 percent voting in favour, and with 39.43 percent voting against.

The councilor-elect in the by-election to fill one seat on Victoria Council, is Marianne Alto.

Official results will be confirmed Wednesday, November 24. The councilor-elect will be sworn in Thursday, December 9th.

16,459 ballots were cast in the referendum, marking a 20 percent increase over the 13,819 cast in the 2002 arena referendum, and is within a few hundred votes of the 17,080 votes cast in the 2008 general election.
