



View Street Parkade to Re-Open 5 a.m. Monday

VICTORIA, BC – Tomorrow morning, the City of Victoria will welcome back parking customers to one of its busiest parkades. View Street Parkade will re-open at 5 a.m. on Monday, March 14 after a nine-day closure to enhance the parkade's frontage to increase public safety and improve the look of the area.

This past week, crews have worked to an ambitious schedule to have the parkade ready to re-open for spring break. The sidewalk has been widened, sight lines improved and it is much more accessible for people who walk, drive and bike. New entrance/exit gates will be installed this spring.

Decorative concrete, new landscaping, and the third driveway exit will be completed once open, with minimal impact to the public.

During construction, the City makes every effort to minimize impacts to local businesses, drivers, pedestrians and cyclists. Parking availability and a positive parking experience are essential to supporting a safe, active and vibrant downtown.
