VICTORIA, BC — On Sunday, November 6 the City of Victoria will celebrate Tree Appreciation Day with new boulevard trees along St. Andrews Street in James Bay.

Media and the public are invited to bring their gloves and join Parks staff in the planting of 17 new Stewartia and Magnolia trees. Parks staff will be on hand to demonstrate how to plant a tree and to answer questions on topics such as tree care and disease prevention.

Tree Appreciation Day is an annual event that recognizes the importance of trees in the urban environment. The City's Urban Forest Master Plan encourages opportunities for community members to participate in tree plantings. Since 2006, this annual event has brought the community together to plant more than 400 trees and shrubs in City Parks.

Parking is available along Douglas Street at Simcoe Street and in Beacon Hill Park. The event will be held rain or shine.
