VICTORIA, BC — On Thursday, November 30 media and the public are invited to a Budget Town Hall on the City's draft 2018 financial plan. A Town Hall is a public meeting where citizens can come and voice their opinion on certain topics outside of a formal Council meeting.

The City's budget determines levels of funding that affects transportation, development, parks and recreation, and other important services that impact everyday life. As presented in the draft financial plan, the 2018 operating budget totals \$233.3 million and the capital budget totals \$43.1 million.

This event provides people an opportunity to ask questions and give feedback in person or from the comfort of their own homes. Participants can submit questions prior to the event, or in real-time during the Town Hall, and then watch the webcast to listen for answers.
