



Paving on Chatham and Caledonia Starts Monday

VICTORIA, BC — The water main replacement project on Chatham Street and Caledonia Avenue is nearing completion and as part of final restoration, paving will take place from Monday to Friday next week. The public can expect traffic disruptions, including lane closures and other restrictions.

The paving work is taking place along Chatham Street and Caledonia Avenue from Government Street to Blanshard Street between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. The work is also weather-dependant so should the weather be unsuitable the paving will be re-scheduled on the next suitable day.

The City and contractor have notified businesses in the area to help reduce impacts to their day-to-day operations and work at intersections will be scheduled outside of traffic times to minimize disruption. Emergency vehicles will have unlimited access. Some delays to traffic are expected. The public is encouraged to use alternate routes if possible.

The project upgraded the legacy cast iron water supply mains that were constructed over 100 years ago in order to deliver high quality water to residents and make upgrades to improve fire suppression capacity and seismic capability.
