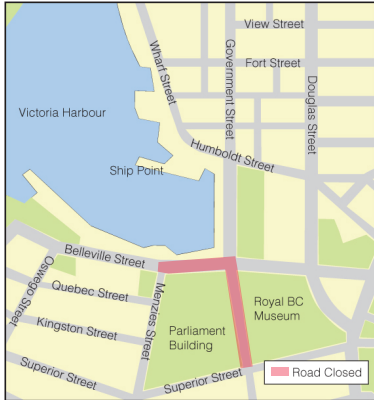




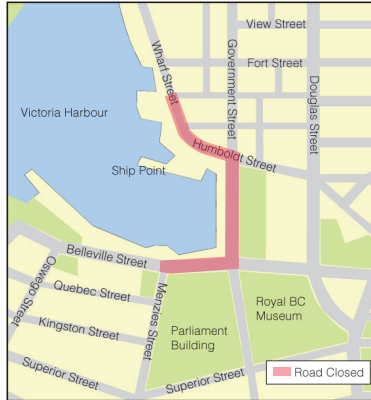

ROAD CLOSURES (MULTIPLE DAYS)

Belleville St (between Menzies St and Government St) will be closed from 9:00AM on June 30 until 12:01AM on July 2.

Government St (between Belleville St and Superior St) from 6:00AM on July 1 until 2:00AM on July 2



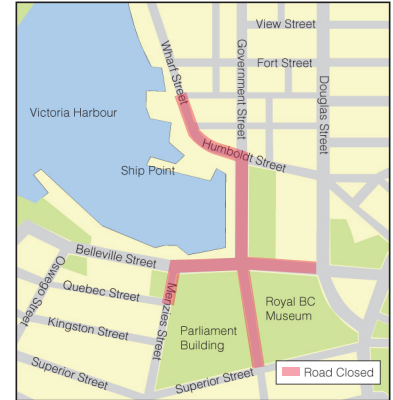
ROAD CLOSURES (FRIDAY, JUNE 30)

Government St (single far southbound lane road closure between the Empress crosswalk and Belleville St.) beginning between 4:30PM-9:00PM

Government St (between Humboldt St and Belleville St) from 9:00PM-11:00PM

Wharf St (between Broughton St and Government St) from 9:00PM-11:00PM

Belleville St (between Menzies St and Government St) from 9:00AM-11:00PM



ROAD CLOSURES (SATURDAY, JULY 1)

Government St (between Humboldt St and Superior St) from 9:00AM-11:00PM

Menzies St (between Belleville St and Quebec St) from 9:00AM-11:00PM

Wharf St (between Broughton St and Government St) from 9:00AM-11:00PM

Saturday Service – **regular fares apply**

Gorge Road Picnic

Gorge Road will be closed to all vehicle traffic between Admirals and Tillicum from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for Canada Day celebrations.

BC Transit will run a shuttle from Tillicum Mall that will follow the regular Route 11 to Gorge at Admirals, then detours along Admirals, Craigflower, Tillicum to Tillicum Mall.

Temporary bus stops on: Craigflower at Admirals and Craigflower at Tillicum (Gorge Golf Course). From these two stops, passengers can connect with Routes 14 and 26. Connect with the Route 11 UVic to downtown, at Tillicum at Gorge (Chevron gas station).

Canada Day Fireworks at Inner Harbour

BC Transit will be operating on “Saturday level service” and adding extra buses on scheduled trips as required.

Due to large crowds during the Canada Day celebrations, a number of bus stops will close after 10:00 p.m. Check this map and watch for route signs at bus stops.

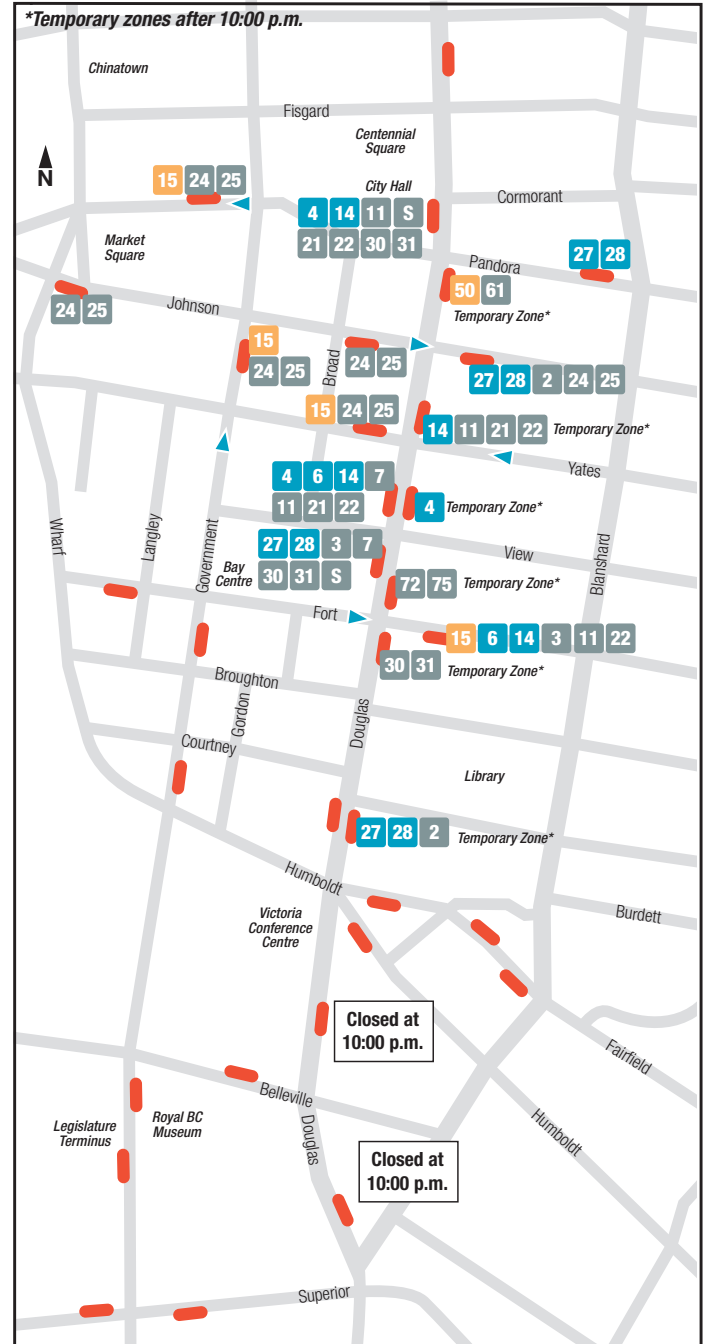
Alcohol Not Permitted On Board – July 1
