VICTORIA, BC — Tomorrow evening, Indigenous Artist in Residence Lindsay Delaronde will host the *Art as Ceremony Celebration* to showcase artworks created by a group of six artists from Our Place community.

The public and the media are invited to attend the free event, meet the artists and view the artwork that was created over a series of 10 workshops led by Delaronde. The celebratory event will showcase a range of art mediums such as cornhusk dolls, medicine pouches, drawings, collage, silk-screen printing, clay and moccasins.
