



900 Block of Johnson Street Closed May 13-15

VICTORIA, BC — Starting Monday, a road closure will take place on Johnson Street between Quadra Street and Vancouver Street (900 block) and is expected to last until end of day Wednesday. The closure is necessary in order to safely disassemble and remove a tower crane.

The closures to vehicle traffic are as follows:

- Monday: 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Tuesday: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Wednesday: 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Local access will be maintained to businesses and homes in the 900 block and the north sidewalk will remain open at all times to pedestrians. Cyclists must dismount and walk their bikes. BC Transit has been notified about the closure and busses are being rerouted as required and local businesses have also been notified.

The public is advised to use caution while travelling near the construction zone and obey all traffic control personnel and signage. The City and its contractor will work to minimize inconveniences during the crane disassembly. If there are high winds or mechanical issues the work could extend into Thursday.
