VICTORIA, BC – Victoria City Council needs your feedback on the City's Draft 2020 Budget and invites you to participate in this week's *Budget Town Hall* on Thursday, November 21 at 6:30 p.m. at Victoria City Hall. Doors will open at 6 p.m. and complimentary refreshments will be provided.

This interactive event provides residents the opportunity to ask questions and give feedback in person or from the comfort of their own homes. Participants can submit questions and comments prior to the event online or in real-time during the Budget Town Hall, and then watch the webcast to listen for answers.

The proposed 2020 Financial Plan allocates \$258.7 million to operate the City's more than 200 programs and services, and invests \$42.1 million in capital infrastructure projects. The City's annual budget enables Council to achieve its 2019-2022 Strategic Plan objectives, including Affordable Housing, Economic Prosperity and Inclusion, Climate Leadership and Environmental Stewardship, and more.
