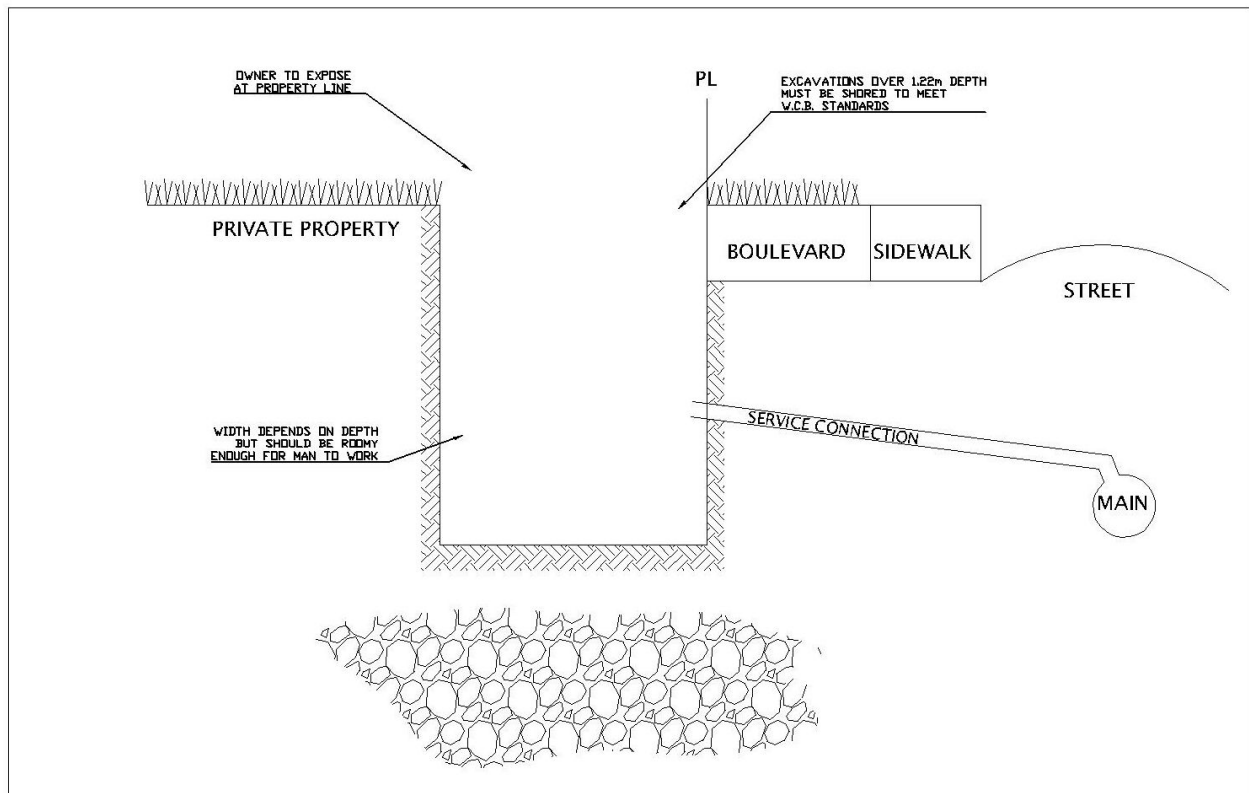


SERVICE CONNECTION TEST FOR RE-USE INFORMATION SHEET

For the price of a Service Connection Test for Re-Use, the Public Works crew will check a maximum of four (4) service connections during one visit. The crew will not return for a second visit until the applicant has re-applied for a Test and Clear.

Once the application is made to the City for a Service Connection Test for Re-use, the applicant shall excavate and expose the existing service connection(s) on the site at the street boundary and shore the excavation to WCB standards as outlined in Part 20 of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations. See diagram above. The City shall install clean-outs on the service connections approved for re-use and cap those services that are not approved for reuse. When the excavation is ready call the City of Victoria Public Works Division (Underground) at 361-0400.

A Public Works crew will be sent out to check the service connection(s). They will perform the following procedures:

1. They will check the service connection(s) with an appropriate inspection device from the property to the main. This procedure is to ensure all joints are good and to check the pipe for any deficiencies, e.g. collapses, settlements or breaks in the service connection(s).
2. They will then dye-test the service connection(s) to confirm whether it is a storm drain or sewer service connection(s).
3. If the service connection(s) passes these inspections, the Public Works crew will install a clean-out on the City side of the property line, tie a blue wire around the storm drain clean out, and a red wire around the sanitary sewer clean-out, and record the measurement of the service connection(s).

If the service connection(s) does not pass inspection it will be capped, at the property line by the City.
