Zoning Regulation Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No. 1148) No. 18-037:

To rezone the lands known as 2616 & 2622-2626 Douglas Street from the C1-N Zone, Neighbourhood Shopping District, to the C1-NC Zone, Neighbourhood Shopping (Cannabis) District, to permit a storefront cannabis retailer.
