1 Alexander	Daily: 6 a.m. – 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. – 10 p.m.
2 Arbutus	Daily: 6 a.m. – 10 p.m.
3 Banfield	Summer: April 1 – September 30 6 a.m. – 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. – 10 p.m. Winter: October 1 – March 31 6 a.m. – 10 p.m.
4 Beacon Hill, south of Dallas Rd., from Douglas St. to Clover Point	Daily: all year round
5 Clover Point	Daily: all year round
6 Gonzales Beach	Daily: September 1 to May 31
7 Oswald	Daily: 6 a.m. – 10 p.m.
8 Pemberton	Daily: 6 a.m. – 10 p.m.
9 Redfern	Daily: 6 a.m. – 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. – 10 p.m.
10 Songhees Hilltop	Daily: 6 a.m. – 10 p.m.
11 Topaz Sportfield	Mon–Fri: 6 a.m. – 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. – 10 p.m. Sat–Sun: 6 a.m. – 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. – 10 p.m. (see park signs for details)
12 Topaz Park – alternate off-leash area	Daily: 6 a.m. – 10 p.m.
13 Victoria West	Daily: 6 a.m. – 10 p.m.

Rules to Paws for:

- Remember to accessorize. Dogs must wear a current year's licence tag on their collar.
- Pick up what your dog is putting down. Pick up dog waste and dispose in a garbage can.
- Playgrounds are for kids. Dogs must remain outside of play area boundaries.
- Be in control of your dog at all times – leash or no leash.
- No digging. Fill in any holes your dog has created.
- Do not let your dog jump up on people.
- Puppies and adolescent dogs should be closely monitored when around mature dominant dogs.
- Use caution when bringing toys and balls. Territorial aggression can occur when other dogs are present.
