



# Cameron Bandshell – Beacon Hill Park

## Venue Information

Cameron Bandshell is an outdoor performance venue, located on the homelands of the Songhees and Esquimalt People in the middle of the City's beautiful Beacon Hill Park. The venue is open from spring until fall.

The Bandshell hosts a variety of events and performances on its stage, including dance, theatre, concerts, choral performances, and community events. All programming at the bandshell is free to attend, and the bench seating and the surrounding grass areas provide a perfect spot for spectators to relax and enjoy performances.



125 benches provide seating for over 500 spectators. There is also plenty of space to bring lawn chairs or spread out your picnic blanket while enjoying the concerts, along with a few picnic tables.

The shell-covered stage is approximately 35' wide x 24' deep with concrete flooring.

Features of the bandshell include two dressing rooms, washrooms, sound system

and chairs. Both front and rear access to the stage is available.

The bandshell's sound system is operated by the venue's sound technician and site services coordinator.
