### Zoning Regulation Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No. 1190) No. 19-059:

To rezone the land known as 553 Raynor Avenue from the R1-B Zone, Single Family Dwelling District, to the R1-B-R Zone, Single Family Dwelling (Raynor) District, to permit an increase in lot area, floor area and height for a single family dwelling constructed prior to 1912.

New Zone: R1-B-R Zone, Single Family Dwelling (Raynor) District

Existing Zone: R1-B Zone, Single Family Dwelling District
