

NOTICE OF ROAD CLOSURE AND REMOVAL OF HIGHWAY DEDICATION BYLAW 22-081  
AND DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY

In accordance with sections 26, 40, and 94 of the *Community Charter*, notice is hereby given that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Victoria proposes to consider adoption of the Cedar Hill Road Closure and Dedication Removal Bylaw, 2022 (No. 22-081) at the October 6, 2022 Daytime Council meeting. This meeting will be held immediately following Committee of the Whole which begins at 9:00 a.m.

Bylaw 22-081 authorizes the City of Victoria to permanently close and remove the highway dedication of the 391.1 square metre portion of dedicated road currently a part of Cedar Hill Road (the "**Closed Road**") boldly outlined on reference plan EPP123857, a reduced copy of which is included below.

Persons who consider they are affected by this Bylaw may make representations to Council by way of written submission by 12:00 p.m. Wednesday October 5, 2022 or by presentation in-person at the October 6, 2022 Daytime Council meeting. Please note that the opinions you express orally and any presentations you submit will be webcast live and will be recorded to form a part of the public record. Correspondence you submit will form part of the public record and will be published on the agenda when this matter is before Council. The City considers your address relevant to this matter and will disclose this personal information, as it informs Council's consideration of your opinion in relation to the subject property and is authorized under section 26(c) of FOIPPA Act. In accordance with section 26(3) of the *Community Charter*, notice is hereby also given of the City's intention to sell in fee simple the Closed Road to The Emanuel of Victoria Vancouver Island, who own the cemetery adjacent to the Closed Road at 2750 Cedar Hill Road. In consideration, the City is receiving the sum of \$70,000. The terms of sale would also provide for the City securing a restrictive covenant on the land restricting its future use for cemetery purposes only.
