

**VEHICLE IMPOUNDMENT BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW (NO. 1)**

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA

The purpose of this bylaw is to amend the *Vehicle Impoundment Bylaw* to:

1. Update the allowable towing and storage charges under section 4(1) to be consistent with the allowable charges under the Towing and Immobilization Companies Bylaw ; and
2. Update section 4(3) to reflect current municipal ticketing authorities and practices.

Under its statutory powers, including section 124(1)(g) of the *Motor Vehicle Act*, sections 8(6), 260 to 265 of the *Community Charter*, and sections 2 and 6 of *Local Government Bylaw Notice Enforcement Act*, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Victoria in an open meeting assembled enacts the following provisions:

**Title**

- 1 This bylaw may be cited as the “Vehicle Impoundment Bylaw, Amendment Bylaw (No. 1)”.

**Amendments**

- 2 The Vehicle Impoundment Bylaw No.02-121 is amended by deleting “driver” wherever it appears and replacing it with “operator”.
- 3 The Vehicle Impoundment Bylaw No. 02-121 is amended by deleting the title of section 4 and replacing it with the following:  
  
“Towing and Impoundment Fee”.
- 4 The Vehicle Impoundment Bylaw No. 02-121 is amended in subsection 4(1)(b) by inserting “and Immobilization” immediately before ‘Companies’.
- 5 The Vehicle Impoundment Bylaw is further amended by striking the text of section 4(3) and replacing it with the following:  
  
“ The payment of any impoundment fee, towing charge or storage charge under this section does not absolve the owner or operator from paying any penalties or fines due and payable in connection with any municipal ticket information or bylaw offence notice issued in relation to a contravention of the Streets and Traffic Bylaw, nor from any fine imposed under the Offence Act.”

**Commencement**

**6** This bylaw comes into force on the date that is 30 days after the date of adoption of this bylaw.
