R-57 ZONE, JOHNSON STREET RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT

Purpose

The purpose of this Zone is to allow additional density for specified amenities and to the extent necessary where density is increased, to provide regulations for a building's height and setback.

Definitions

2 In the R-57 Zone, Johnson Street Residential District,

"Amenities" means the following:

(a) A Housing Agreement pursuant to Section 905 of the Local Government Act providing for a minimum of 50% of adaptable housing units in this Zone, and requiring that all housing units in this Zone must be capable of being rented to tenants.

Permitted Uses

- The following uses are the only uses permitted in this Zone:
 - (a) residential, including without limitation, <u>multiple dwellings</u>, rest homes, nursing homes, <u>hospitals</u>, and care facilities;
 - (b) institutions of a religious, educational, charitable, or philanthropic character;
 - (c) offices, banks, and financial institutions;
 - (d) retail;
 - (e) <u>restaurants</u>;
 - (f) personal services;
 - (g) theatres, auditoriums, and places of recreation;
 - (h) day care;
 - (i) <u>launderettes</u>;
 - (j) home occupations;
 - (k) <u>high tech;</u>
 - (I) call centre.

Location of Use Within a Building

A non-residential use, excluding <u>home occupations</u>, may be located only in a basement or on a first or second storey.

General regulations

Except as provided in this Part, the regulations applicable in the R-3-C Zone, Central Area Residential District apply in this Zone.
