



2026 GENERAL LOCAL ELECTION OFFICIAL NOTICE ADVANCE ELECTOR REGISTRATION

On Saturday, October 17, 2026, the next general local election will be held.

Is your name on the Provincial Voters List?

You can verify if you are registered on the list by visiting www.victoria.ca/elections.

If you are not on the list, you may register by visiting www.elections.bc.ca.

Advance elector registration closes at **4:00 p.m. on August 25, 2026.**

ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS

RESIDENT ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS:

A resident elector must:

- Be 18 years of age or older on general voting day;
- Be a Canadian citizen;
- Have been a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration;
- Be a resident of the City of Victoria;
- Not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act*, or any other enactment from voting in local elections or be otherwise disqualified by law.

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS:

A non-resident property elector must:

- Be 18 years or older on general voting day;
- Be a Canadian citizen;
- Have been a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration;
- Be the registered owner of real property in the City of Victoria for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration;
- Be the only persons who are registered owners of the property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust;
- Not be entitled to register as a resident elector;
- Not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act*, or any other enactment from voting in local elections or be otherwise disqualified by law.
- If there is more than one registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.
