



Campership Adjudicator Form

Adjudicator (Please Read Carefully)

The purpose of the adjudicator form is to provide an alternative for applicants of the Campership program when they are unable to provide proof of income through a recent Notice of Assessment (NOA).

It is a requirement that the adjudicator be familiar with the applicant’s financial situation as their verbal confirmation verifies the applicant meets the eligibility criteria. The adjudicator must have a company email address and an active phone number for a verbal verification.

While Campership aims to support as many families as possible, due to limited funds available not every application will be awarded Campership. Successful applicants will be selected via lottery system.

The reference can be:

- Social Worker or Family Services Worker
- School Principal, Teacher or Counsellor
- Doctor or Healthcare Professional
- Spiritual leader
- Lawyer or Notary Public
- Housing Assistant or Support Advocate

The Campership Program aims to remove financial barriers making it easier for youth to access enriching and fun camp experiences. To qualify for the campership program individuals must be at or below the low-income threshold

Consent

The applicant is responsible for notifying their adjudicator. Staff will contact the adjudicator to verbally verify the applicant’s eligibility.

The adjudicator verifies that the applicant(s) listed above require financial assistance and endorse that they would otherwise be unable to access camp opportunities.

The personal information the Reference Form collects is an alternative method of determining eligibility for those who would likely qualify, but do not have the necessary documents to confirm their eligibility. Section 26(c) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act is the legislated authority to collect the personal information for the purpose described.
