IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 59 (2)(b) OF THE COMMUNITY CHARTER, PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the City of Victoria is seeking your input on proposed changes to the Towing and Immobilizing Companies Bylaw, the Vehicle Impoundment Bylaw and Towing and Immobilizing Companies Consequential Amendments Bylaw.

Key changes to the bylaws include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Update the fees which may be charged in relation to the towing and storage of vehicles from parking lots;
- Address modern parking payment methods and infrastructure; and
- Reflect current municipal ticketing authorities and practices.
